Meeting brought to order

Pledge of Allegiance

All three supervisors in attendance: Tom Stull, Jr, Dan Pribisco, Jay Siesky and twp. secretary Trudy Harkcom

Public Comment: Lisa stated just wanted to see what was new in the township

New Business: Resolution 2024-5..A Resolution of Donegal Township Supervisors providing for Auditor Compensation. Motion by Dan, seconded by Jay, all agreed.

Discussion on Solar Farm Ordinance for Donegal Township....Solicitor Dan Hewitt stated being Donegal Township has no zoning Ordinance it would be beneficial for the health and welfare of the township residents to have an ordinance in place to help regulate setbacks, and for the de-commissioning of the solar farm that has an average of 25-30 years. Dan Hewitt stated that a bond would be required for the clean-up of the farm once de-commissioned. Motion by Dan to authorize the solicitor to advertise the Ordinance, Tom seconded, all agreed.

Motion by Tom to move forward with the TIP program thru Penn-Dot to have the bridge on Donegal Lake road off of Route 130 for replacement within 5 years. Penn-dot will provide funding with township supplying a % of costs. Jay seconded, all agreed.

Dan stated that the township will contact Brandon Firestone, Township Penn-dot representative for preparing a paving project on Lower end of Old Franklin, Roaring Run Rd., and Tannery Rd to Rte. 31. To be placed out for Bids.
