Motion by Tom to send a letter to the Pike Run Country Club as Donegal Township has been asked to comment on apending application by the Pike Run Country Club's submission to the PA Game Commission for a non-commercial regulated hunting permit on the Club property. The Township Board of Supervisors has been advised that this will allow the club members to hunt on the club property.
