Meeting Brought to Order

Pledge of Allegiance

Supervisors Dan Pribisco, Jay Siesky, and Christopher Younkin and Township Secretary Keith White in attendance

Christopher Younkin made a motion to approve the minutes of January's meeting. Jay Siesky seconded, and the motion carried.

Jay Siesky made a motion to pay all listed and upcoming bills. Dan Pribisco seconded and the motion carried.

New Business:

Jay Siesky made a motion to purchase a tarp building using the previously awarded LSA Category 4 grant funds at a cost of \$111,178.75. Christopher Younkin seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Jay Siesky made a motion to approve advertisement for road material bids to be opened at the March regular meeting. Christopher Younkin seconded the motion, and the motion carried

Christopher Younkin made a motion to approve payment to Hickes Corporation in the amount of \$147,799.80. Dan Pribisco seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Jay Siesky made a motion to approve payment to Ligonier Construction in the amount of \$63,569.31. Dan Pribisco seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Jay Siesky made a motion to submit a reimbursement request to the LSA grant for the above mentioned sewage construction bills. Christopher Younkin seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Christopher Younkin made a motion to submit a reimbursement request to PENNVEST for engineering costs. Jay Siesky seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Gary Leister gave a sewage construction update, stating that the construction conference scheduled for February 17, 2026 may be cancelled due to the limited amount of work being done because of weather. Gary also stated that the proposed revisions to the project have been submitted to DEP and Westmoreland Conservation District for review. Emails regarding the water leak at Champion Christian School have been received and are being worked through with the contractors and the school.

Old Business:

Dan Pribisco stated that Skyview Bridge repair will be completed as soon as there is a weekend with suitable weather. The repair was delayed due to issues with the galvanization of the decking, but all materials are now on hand.
