Meeting Brought to Order

Pledge of Allegiance

Supervisors Dan Pribisco, Jay Siesky, and Christopher Younkin and Township Secretary Keith White in attendance

Public in Attendance: Gary Leister, EADS Group, Jason McGinnis, and Kerry Witt, ICV Water Authority

Christopher Younkin made a motion to approve the minutes of February's meeting. Jay Siesky seconded, and the motion carried.

Jay Siesky made a motion to pay all listed and upcoming bills. Dan Pribisco seconded and the motion carried.

Public Comment: None

New Business:

Jay Siesky made a motion to approve the 2026-2027 COSTARS Salt contract in the amount of 450 tons. Dan Pribisco seconded, and the motion carried.

Bids for road materials were opened, and the awarding of bids was tabled until the March 24, 2026 special meeting to ensure that all paperwork is in order. Bids were received from New Enterprise Stone and Lime, Heidelberg Materials, Amerikohl Aggregates, Midland Asphalt Materials, and Russell Standard Corporation.

Dan Pribisco made a motion to approve a sewage contractor pay request from Hickes Associates in the amount of \$614,178.90. Jay Siesky seconded the motion, and the motion carried

Jay Siesky made a motion to submit a reimbursement request to the LSA grant in the amount of \$333,930.78 for expenses incurred due to the above payment request. This would expend all funds available for this grant. Christopher Younkin seconded the motion, and the motion carried

Jay Siesky made a motion to submit a reimbursement request to the H2O grant in the amount of \$186,841.42 for the balance of the above payment request. Dan Pribisco seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Christopher Younkin made a motion to submit a reimbursement request to the PENNVEST construction loan in the amount of \$93,480.46 to provide the match needed for the H2O funds. Jay Siesky seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Dan Pribisco made a motion to submit a reimbursement request in the amount of \$23,716.13 to the PENNVEST engineering loan for expenses incurred during the month. Jay Siesky seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Gary Leister gave an update on the sewage project, stating that a construction conference will be held on March 17, 2026 at 10am. Work on the project was minimal in February due to weather, but contractors are planning to restart work this week. He also stated that approval for the minor alignment change was received from the Westmoreland Conservation District.

Old Business:

Work is complete on Skyview Bridge, and the township is currently awaiting the completion of the engineering process to get the weight limit on the bridge updated.

Jay Siesky made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Christopher Younkin
