Meeting brought to order

All 3 Supervisors in attendance: Tom Stull, Jr., Dan Pribisco, Jay Siesky and Twp Sec. Trudy Harkcom

Public in attendance: Dan Hewitt, Township Solicitor, Carol Pohl, Tax Collector, and Jennifer Burrell resident.

No Public Comment

New Business: Dan made motion to award all pick-up stone material at plant to New Enterprise Stone & Lime Co., Inc. and to award all stone material to be delivered as directed by the township to Amerikohl Aggregates, Inc. Tom seconded all agreed. No bid was awarded for Anfi-Skid material.

The Supervisors addressed the letter they received from Carol Pohl, Tax Collector, requesting her resignation from the office of the Township Tax Collector effective March 31, 2025. Motion by Dan to approve the resignation from Carol Pohl effective March 31, 2025 and will accept resumes from those interested in filling the vacancy until the new elected tax collector will take office in 2026. All resumes will be accepted until April 14, 2025 the next regular township monthly meeting. Jay seconded, all agreed.

Supervisors will have information about the tax collector office being closed from April 1, 2025 until after April 14, 2025 on the township website. The County has informed those township's who have received their tax bills late (due to the County machinery needing repaired) that the discount period will be extended until May 12, 2025 and the face will be extended until July 12th, 2025.

Township Solicitor Dan Hewitt stated that a few of the Right of Ways for businesses affected by the Township Sewage project will be notified again. The township will get the Local Government Debt Act completed as is required for Sewage Project. Township has no outstanding debt.
