Public Comment Period: Donegal Borough Solicitor Lane Tutulrie did an update on the Borough's progress with the Act 537 update, and seeking funding for the Donegal Borough Sewage project. They are working with USDA but need more information for the application process. Dan Hewitt stated that the borough needs to do a formal letter of request to the township on what info the borough needs. Dan Hewitt stated that township will not do any type of agreement with Donegal Borough until the Pennvest loan is done and funding is in place for the Donegal Twp Sewage Project. The Township will not pay for any costs that the Borough will have in doing their sewage project. The extra capacity that is in the plans for the Sewage plant now is for the Donegal Twp residents only for future growth. The Borough will pay for added modules onto the treatment plant as they need at their costs. The DEP Consent Order that was given to the township does not include the Borough.
