Meeting brought to order

Pledge of Allegiance

Those in attendance: all 3 Supervisors: Tom Stull, Jr., Dan Pribisco, Jay Siesky, and twp. secretary Trudy Harkcom

Public in attendance: Nathan Kiliany, Liz Brady, Kim DeMarchi

Motion by Dan to approve last month's meeting minutes, Jay seconded, all agreed

Public Comment Period: Nathan Kiliany stated he lives on Blue Rock Rd. and asked if Camp Run Rd will ever be paved? Tom stated that 15 years ago the residents and the twp. talked about it, but still remains a dirt road. Nathan then stated that he was installing solar panels at his home and that K2 engineering told him he would have to have a weight bearing analysis done and that an engineer would have to give K2 a letter that this was done. Solicitor Dan Hewitt stated that the township has K2 engineering to do the 3rd party inspections and the township goes with K2 Engineering guidelines. Dan Hewitt told Nathan that he could file a complaint against K2 engineering and that K2 has the forms to do that.
