New Business: Motion by Dan to approve Resolution # 2025-6...A Resolution for setting forth the official intent to reimburse the Township General Funds used to construct improvements to its sanitary sewer collection and treatment facilities with funds received from the Pennsylvania Infrastructure Investment Authority in the amount of \$670,000.00, relating to engineering and architectural expenses and interim basis using its general fund until the proceeds of the PennVest Debt obligation are received. Jay seconded, all agreed

Motion by Dan to approve Resolution # 2025-7...A Resolution setting forth the official intent to reimbursement the Township General funds used to construct improvements to its sanitary sewer collection and treatment facilities with funds received from the Pennsylvania Infrastructure Investment Authority relating to construction expenses and interim basis using its general fund until the proceeds of the PennVest Debt obligation are received in the amount of \$1,169,595.00. Tom seconded, all agreed.

Motion by Dan to approve Solicitor Fee Agreement for loan of \$1,169,595.00. Daniel J. Hewitt, Esquire, of the Avolio Law Group, LLC am duly appointed Solicitor to the Township of Donegal and the Board of Supervisors will represent the Township throughout the closing of Penn Vest Project No. 65250215403-CS, pursuant to my existing solicitor agreement with the Township with fees which shall not exceed \$40,000.00.
