Monthly Meeting Minutes

November 10, 2025

Meeting Brought to Order

Pledge of Allegiance

Supervisors Tom Stull Jr., Dan Pribisco, and Jay Siesky, township secretary Trudy Harkcom, and assistant secretary Keith White in attendance.

Public in Attendance: Gary Leister, EADS Group, Brian Brown, Dick Garrity, Michael and Ruthann Leon, Bob Horrell, Debi Newquist

Jay Siesky made a motion to approve October's meeting minutes, with a second by Tom Stull Jr. Motion carried

Dan Pribisco made a motion to pay all listed and upcoming bills, with a second by Jay Siesky. Motion carried.

Public Comment: Dick Garrity inquired as to whether a cost to individual residents for sewage has been determined. Gary Leister of the EADS Group stated that no rate has been established yet. Total construction costs for the sewage project are expected to be approximately 10 million dollars, 85% of which is funded by grant money. The expected loan amount to complete the project is 1.8 million dollars, which is what the rate will be based upon. However, Gary stated that the rate will not be established until the project is completed and final costs are determined.

Debi Newquist asked where the sewage facility is to be located. Tom Stull replied that the facility will be placed approximately where the Laurel Highlands Campground plant is currently located.

Mike Leon asked whether the materials have been purchased to repair Skyview Bridge. Dan Pribisco stated that the materials have been ordered, and the anticipated delivery time is 30-45 days after ordering plus the time required to ship the material from Indiana. Dan also stated that residents will be notified by phone or mail when work is scheduled to begin on the bridge.

Mike Leon also asked whether the supervisors are finished working on Aukerman Road. Dan Pribisco stated that work is not finished yet. Banks are done being filled, but several sections of pipe need to be installed.

New Business:

Dan Pribisco made a motion to submit a reimbursement request to the township's H2O grant for engineering costs incurred during the sewage project. Tom Stull seconded, and the motion carried.

Gary Leister gave an update on the sewage project, stating that work on contract 1 began on October 27, 2025 and work on the collection system is tentatively scheduled to begin on November 17, 2025. Future engineering costs will be reimbursed out of the PENNVEST loan. A construction conference is scheduled for December 16, 2025 at the township building.

Dan Pribisco made a motion to approve Resolution 2025-10, requesting a statewide local share account grant to be used for construction of an addition to the township office building. Tom Stull seconded. Motion carried.

Old Business:

The 2025 Dirt and Gravel Road project on Aukerman Road is almost done.

An application has been submitted for a 2026 Dirt and Gravel Road project to improve the steep hill on Skyview Road.

Dan Pribisco made a motion to adjourn seconded by Jay Siesky.
