Meeting Brought to Order

Pledge of Allegiance

Supervisors Dan Pribisco, Jay Siesky, and Christopher Younkin and Township Secretary Keith White in attendance

Public in Attendance: Andy Fedorko, EADS Group; Jason McGinnis; Paul Britain, Daily Courier

Christopher Younkin made a motion to approve the minutes of the June meeting. Jay Siesky seconded, and the motion carried.

Jay Siesky made a motion to pay all listed and upcoming bills. Christopher Younkin seconded, and the motion carried.

Public Comment: None

New Business:

Dan Pribisco made a motion to issue a letter of support to the U.S. Economic Development Association in support of efforts by Jane Altman to raise funds for the proposed River Art Works complex in Champion, PA. Jay Siesky seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Dan Pribisco made a motion to approve Resolution 2026-04, approving the Plan No. 6 Subdivision for Pike Run Country Club. Christopher Younkin seconded, and the motion carried.

Dan Pribisco made a motion to approve pay request # 8 from Hickes Associates in the amount of \$478,953.17. Christopher Younkin seconded, and the motion carried.

Jay Siesky made a motion to approve contractor pay request # 6 from Ligonier Construction in the amount of \$153,903.65. Dan Pribisco seconded, and the motion carried.

Dan Pribisco made a motion to submit reimbursement request #7 to the PENNVEST construction loan in the amount of \$632,933.24 to cover the above mentioned contractor pay requests. Christopher Younkin seconded, and the motion carried.

Dan Pribisco made a motion to submit reimbursement request # 7 to the PENNVEST engineering loan in the amount of \$27,300.27 to cover EADS Group expenses since the last reimbursement request. Christopher Younkin seconded, and the motion carried.

Old Business:

Dan Pribisco stated that further review of the trail crossing request previously submitted by the Mountain Watershed Authority shows the need for a traffic study, engineering, and proper visibility and signage as required by PENNDOT. The Board agreed to table this issue until next month's meeting so that further discussions may take place with the township solicitor regarding the township's liability.

Dan Pribisco stated that Lamar advertising has offered to purchase a permanent easement for signs on township property at the intersection of Rt. 31 and Rt. 711 for \$60,000. Under the current lease terms, the township is averaging approximately #3,400 per year from the lease. Christopher Younkin made a motion to continue under the current lease. Dan Pribisco seconded, and the motion carried.

Dan Pribisco stated that the roadway lines have been repainted at the intersection of Route 31 and Kings Way.

Dan Pribisco asked that township residents show patience as many roads have been washed out by recent heavy rains. Dan Pribisco further stated that the township will get to each road and asked that residents bear with the road crew as they address these issues.

Christopher Younkin made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Jay Siesky
